Dear Local Residents,

I write to you with notification of an event which will be held on the 20th and 21st August, with participants cycling a 310 mile route from Newcastle to London. They will aim to complete this route within 24 hours.

There will be approximately 900 participants taking part in this event; raising money for Macmillan and a number of different charities. Participants will Newcastle in staggered intervals, helping to protect the environment and lessen the impact on the local community. All participants taking part share the same focus of raising much needed funds for charity.

We wanted to notify you of the event as the route passes close to your home and wanted to avoid any inconvenience.

In order to ensure the impact on the roads and to traffic is kept to a minimum the cyclists will be starting on the 20th August at 11:00 and 12:00. No roads will be shut for this event and all cyclists will be following the highway code. Furthermore, we will remove all rubbish, signs, and branding once the last person has started, ensuring we return everything to its original condition.

We will be using the Sports Hall and dining area at Queen Margaret's School as a rest stop for the participants. Participants will access the school via the main entrance and then leave via the pedestrian entrance on Main Street. We will have staff arriving from 14:30 on the 20th August and our first rider will be due to arrive at 16:51. Our last rider will be due to depart at 19:56 on the 20th August. There will be no noise above normal levels and there will be no disruption to the local area.

EVENT PLANNING INFORMATION

- Route is fully marked with pink arrows
- Marshals, Guides and medics will patrol the route.
- Road warning signs (for both traffic and participants) where necessary.
- All signage removed after the last participants have passed through.
- All participants are requested to follow the highway code.
- Event clear-up includes collection of any rubbish along route.
- Event management plan includes risk assessment and contingency plans in case of unexpected events (i.e. extreme weather conditions).
