Major Resurfacing Works on A63 Selby Bypass

The carriageway surface is now complete and the lining crews are now on site putting down the road markings:-



Contractors are in the final stages of preparing the bridge deck, once the kerbing is finished it will be ready for surfacing which is due to start on Monday:-



To make full use of the road closure Contractors are on site cutting the verges / hedges, clearing vegetation from around road signs and litter picking.

There is a noted reduction in volume of traffic which is possibly due to the surfacing dressing work currently underway on the A19 between Osgodby roundabout and Escrick, however the town centre still remains congested at peak times.
